## SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Dixie Sun Elementary has a mandatory uniform policy adopted May 2010 and updated May 2012. It is the responsibility of each parent and student to make sure that they are in compliance with the School Uniform Policy. All clothing worn to school should be clean and in good repair. All visible clothing worn within the school must conform to school colors.

### Tops/Shirts:

Students must wear white, sky blue, navy blue, or pale yellow collared shirts (long or short sleeved). Styles can include polo-style knit shirts, button-down shirts or turtle neck collar shirts. Shirts should be plain - not have writing or images. Any logos should be discreet and less than one inch in diameter. If a long-sleeve shirt is worn under a short-sleeve shirt it must also be school colors. The Dixie Sun school T-shirt is to be worn on P.E. day along with khaki or navy pants or shorts. (Currently PE day is Monday for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades and Tuesday for the rest of the school.)

### Bottoms:

Students must wear navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, capris, skorts, skirts or jumpers. Girls can wear only white or navy tights with their skirts or jumpers in the colder months. Leggings are only to be worn under a skirt or shorts, not by themselves and must be uniform colors. Skirts and shorts must be of sufficient length to exceed the fingertips with the arms extended. **No jeans are allowed at school. Sweatpants can only be worn on their PE day.**

### Shoes:

Any shoe can be worn to school but comfortable brown or black shoes are recommended. All students are urged to wear athletic shoes on P.E. day. "Flip-flops" are forbidden.

### Coats and Jackets:

Students may wear any coat or jacket to school. Any outerwear worn in the classroom must comply with school colors. No writing, images or logos except the school logo.

### Uniform-Free Days:

At the school's discretion, certain days may be designated as "uniform free" days or theme days where something other than the school uniform may be worn. That includes the last Friday of every month where the students donate \$1 to the Uniform Assistance program, in order to wear other school appropriate clothing.
